CERTIFICATE OF ELECTRICAL INSPECTION
for
SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING

State law [Title 32 M.R.S.A .§1102-D(4)] prohibits utility companies from activating the electricity to a newly constructed single-family dwelling until the company receives certification by a state or local inspector, master electrician or limited electrician in house wiring, that the wiring complies with the National Electrical Code. This requirement does not apply to the installation of manufactured/mobile home wiring or services.
