We work every day to deliver your energy safely and reliably. We also strive to keep the air clean in our communities by helping to install electric vehicle (EV) charging stations and convert streetlights to LEDs across the state.



Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

Since May of 2021, when we launched our pilot 60-plug pilot program, we have helped to fund the installation of 48 EV charging stations at 13 locations across the state. We will be installing 12 more stations at one location in 2022. Since the pilot program was so successful, we may offer an ongoing incentive program in the future.

Electric vehicles and plug-in hybrid electric vehicles offer low maintenance, low environmental impact and good fuel economy. We want to make charging your electric or plug-in hybrid electric vehicle easy and convenient.

LED Streetlights

To date, we have helped 178 towns, cities and villages convert 34,168 streetlights to LEDs. LED streetlights cost 30-40% less to operate than non-LED streetlights, they have long lives resulting in less outages, require less maintenance and they even reduce carbon monoxide emissions.

It's easy. Call **811** or visit **digsafe.com** before you dig. State law requires you give at least 72 hours notice, not including weekends and legal holidays, before starting your project.

It's free. Utility representatives will visit the site to mark the location of underground electric, gas, water and any other utility-owned facilities.

It's the law. Accidentally digging into underground utilities can cause personal injury, environmental harm and costly damage.
