The following questions pertain to the spreadsheet file "Attachment 3 - Central Maine Power - Att F - App A (ATRR)" and Central Maine Power's 2023 FERC Form 1:

- Q: In reference to Central Maine Power's 2023 FERC Form 1 page 206, line 95, Column c, Account 398 Miscellaneous Equipment, what is the nature of the 2023 Additions in the amount of \$3,516,763? Please provide a detailed listing of the 2023 Additions for this account.
- A: Please see MPUC-CMP-1-35 Attachment 1 for the nature and detailed listing of the 2023 Additions in Account 398 Miscellaneous Equipment in the amount of \$3,516,763.

Please note while preparing this response, CMP determined that certain plant additions recorded in 2023 were inadvertently recorded in FERC account 398 - Miscellaneous Equipment rather than FERC account 353 – Station Equipment. All else equal, this error reduced CMP's proposed revenue requirement since FERC Account 398 - Miscellaneous Equipment is allocated to transmission through the wage allocation factor while FERC account 353 – Station Equipment is 100% directly assigned to transmission. As described in CMP's response to MPUC-CMP-1-02, CMP will resubmit its proposed RNS and LNS revenue requirements to the ISO-NE Participating Transmission Owners Administrative Committee ("PTO AC") following its August meeting to correct this error prior to rates taking effect January 1, 2025.
